**Under this agreement for 2017  
Jindalee State School will receive**

**\$295,024\***

## This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students achieving in NAPLAN U2B in Year 3 from:
  - Reading: 70% to 75%
  - Writing: 62% to 67%
  - Numeracy: 47% to 55%
- Increase the percentage of students achieving in NAPLAN U2B in Year 5 from:
  - Reading: 48% to 60%
  - Writing: 19% to 40%
  - Numeracy: 33% to 45%
- Ensure every child achieves a PM reading level of 5 or higher at the completion of Prep.
- Assist Indigenous students achieve above NAPLAN NMS
- Increase all Year 1 reading levels to meet or exceed Regional Reading Benchmarks by December 2017

## Our initiatives include

- Engaging trained intervention Teacher Aides and Teacher to provide differentiated task orientated lessons for reading and numeracy in all grades.
- Increased reading intervention in Prep aided by the purchase of additional beginner reading resources for levels 1-4.
- Full time release from teaching duties for the HOSSES to enable additional time management and implementation of the Whole School Approach to Student Support.
- Specialist Robotics and Coding lessons to extend and challenge mathematical skills and knowledge
- Purchase and implementation of Multi-Lit for Year 1 reading improvement.
- Engagement of key teachers across all year levels to create and implement a school-wide writing program
