## This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students achieving a C and higher in English to 94% for Prep to Year 6.

## Our initiatives include

- Provide time for year levels to meet in Year Level Meetings and planning sessions to review and analyse student data in Writing, to inform differentiation and next teaching and learning steps, to monitor student improvement in Writing and re-assess teaching strategies, intervention and programs to align with current student data to improve Writing and English A-E outcomes.
- Providing teachers time to watch others work and mentor each other around the teaching of Writing.
- Analysing assessment task data to inform next English unit teaching and learning cycle, differentiation and strategies to improve student outcomes.
- Additional teacher aide time to assist with early intervention, PD and implementation of an oral language program for Prep students.
- Utilising the Head of Department Curriculum to work alongside teachers to implement with fidelity our whole school pedagogy for Writing and Reading – the Teaching and Learning Cycle.

Utilising Intervention and learning support teacher aides to support students in Writing and Reading	\$120,000.00
Create and purchase intervention resources to support the intervention programs	\$2,000.00
Provide teacher aide time for speech and language programs	\$10,000.00
Provide release time for teachers to participate in Professional Development opportunities and planning meetings to discuss writing assessment task data and plan for student improvement in English, particularly Writing and time for teachers to mentor and watch others work.	\$75,024.00
Employ Head of Department Curriculum to work with teachers	\$88,000.00
